

Switzerland's chairmanship of the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) in 2017

1. Background, key dates, issues

Switzerland's chairmanship of IHRA

The International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) is an intergovernmental body whose purpose is to promote historical research and education about the Holocaust and to preserve the memory of victims through commemorations and memorials, especially in its 31 member countries. IHRA was initiated in 1998 by former Swedish Prime Minister Göran Persson

On 5 November 2015, the representatives of the 31 member countries of the IHRA accepted Switzerland's candidacy to chair the organization in 2017.

Switzerland will take over chairmanship of the IHRA in March 2017 with FDFA secretary general, Ambassador Benno Bättig, as chair for one year.

In her message on International Holocaust Remembrance Day (27.01.2017), Swiss President Doris Leuthard stressed that Switzerland wants to use its chairmanship of the IHRA to ensure that the crimes committed by the Nazi regime against the Jews, Roma, Sinti and other minorities are never forgotten. This should also help build a bridge between the past and the present.

- Switzerland will organize two IHRA plenary meetings, the first in Geneva (26-29 June) and the second in Bern (27-30 November).
