

Checklist for National visa (type D): Student with a stay in Switzerland for more than 90 days

Documents for Student Visa are accepted by the Embassy of Switzerland in Kazakhstan only in Astana. Applications must be submitted in person.

Appointment to the Embassy should be scheduled through the visa centre: https://visa.vfsglobal.com/kaz/ru/che/

If your documents are not in a Swiss language (German, French, Italian), or English, they need to be translated in one of the aforementioned languages.

Proof of financial means , bank statements or bank certificates of the student or parents in order to prove sufficient financial means to cover the costs of studying in Switzerland. Original and 2 copies.	
If sponsored: a signed and dated sponsorship letter will have to be submitted along with a copy of the sponsor's passport (pages with photo, personal data and signature only) and his/her bank statements.	
Proof of languages skills such as TOEFL or IELTS certificates. German, French or Italian language certificates, if available.	
 Minors: a) Birth certificate.(copy) b) Only if the minor travels alone: original authorization signed by their parents and copy of passports of parents. 	

Please note that:

The Embassy of Switzerland reserves the right to ask for additional documents and/or for a personal interview.

Visas for Students with the purpose of Study in Switzerland are free of charge.

The complete application will be forwarded to the <u>cantonal immigration authority</u> for decision. The procedure takes at least 12 weeks. Once the application has been approved, you will have to submit your original passport to this Embassy in order to obtain your visa.
