For example, the SwissAl event showcased Switzerland's leadership in innovation, fostering new opportunities for Swiss Kuwaiti partnership also in advanced technologies. Our cultural exchanges were equally notable, with highlights such as the Swiss Film Night and the Ladies' Diplomatic Night with its chocolate workshop, which celebrated Swiss gastronomic traditions.

My team and I are very happy to interact with all of you and look forward to seeing you again soon to foster the excellent relations between our countries.

THE EMBASSY IN ACTION

Strengthening Bilateral Ties in New York

The Swiss President, Ms. Viola Amherd, met with the the Crown Prince of Kuwait, H.H. Sheikh Sabah Khaled Al Sabah, on the sidelines of the United Nations General Assembly in New York (kuna). This



meeting reaffirmed the long-standing friendship and the positive relations between our two countries. It also addressed shared concerns, including regional stability and upcoming milestones, such as the 60th anniversary of diplomatic relations in 2026. The meeting underscored the importance of maintaining an open dialogue, to promote mutual understanding and cooperation for the benefit of all.



Visit of the Special Envoy for the MENA Region

The Swiss Special Envoy for the MENA Region, Ambassador Wolfgang A. Brülhart, began his GCC tour by landing in Kuwait on the 30.11. We had good meetings at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, with Assistant Foreign Minister for Europe Sadiq Marafi, and Assistant Foreign Minister for Human Rights, Sheikha Jawaher Al Sabah. The regional situation,

our good relations, common interests and opportunities to further develop the cooperation were discussed, e.g. with regard to mediation, human rights and the important role of women in the promotion of peace and security.



On the same occasion, the Swiss Delegation was invited to the Palace of H.H. Sheikh Nasser Al-Mohammed Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah – the very first Rep-



resentative Ωf Kuwait officially accredited to the Swiss Government in 1966 for a very friendly ех-

change and an extremely interesting conversation about the regional context and its perspectives.

The Embassy has organized a wide range of events and initiatives aimed at deepening the friendship between Switzerland and Kuwait. From advancing economic collaboration and promoting Swiss innovation

to fostering cultural exchanges, these activities have showcased the shared values and strong ties between the two nations, generating at the same time a positive media coverage in Kuwait.

Ambassador's Interview on Good Morning Kuwait: Strengthening our bilateral relations

In a recent live interview on *KTV2 - Good Morning Kuwait* (available here), the Swiss Ambassador Tiziano Balmelli highlighted the longstanding and strong relationship between Switzerland and Kuwait, which has now spanned nearly a century. The Ambassador discussed how Kuwaitis have a deep appreciation for Switzerland, with many choosing it as their destination for both leisure and investment. The similarities in mentality between the Swiss and Kuwaitis make it easier to establish successful business partnerships.



Ambassador Balmelli emphasized the importance of promoting dialogue and fostering mutual understanding, which are key to creating further opportunities for collaboration. One such platform for enhancing business relations is the Swiss Kuwaiti Business Platform, which facilitates meaningful exchanges and promotes cooperation between the two countries. The Ambassador also underscored Switzerland's support for Kuwait's priority of attracting investors, particularly in sectors such as food security, where there is great potential for collaboration and innovation. Both countries share a strong commitment to innovation and sustainability.

Aiglon College: A Long Tradition of Excellence

A special gathering at the White Palace, hosted by H.E. Sheikh Mubarak A.M. Al Sabah, celebrated the strong ties between Switzerland and Kuwait through Aiglon College. Alumni, current parents, and representatives of the Swiss educational institution joined the event, including H.E. Sheikh Faisal Salem Sabah



Al Sabah, the first Kuwaiti student to attend the college in the 1950s. The gathering highlighted the strong connections built through Swiss education, and attendees shared their thoughts and experiences on how a Swiss education can help shaping a successful future.

Swiss-Kuwaiti Business Platform

The Swiss-Kuwaiti Business Platform continued its dynamic activities over the past months, encouraging cooperation and economic exchange between Switzerland and Kuwait. For example, in November, on the occasion of the visit of the CEO of Vontobel Bank, the platform organized a special evening of dialogue and networking with a small group of representatives of the local business community, at the Swiss Residence.

a wonderful Swiss-Kuwaiti agricultural initiative enhancing food security and sustainability through aeroponic technology. We saw firsthand how very tasty local Kuwaiti crops are grown using innovative methods brought to Kuwait by GreenlifeGCC.

Exploring AI opportunities with SwissAI
