Visa Section

Visa for celebration of marriage in Switzerland with take up of residence over 90 days (applies also to same gender)

!! Important information !!

The process involves:

- 1) The Civil Status Offices in Switzerland (Chancery First step)
- 2) The Migration Offices in Switzerland (Visa Section Second step)

First Step:

Applicants who wish to marry in Switzerland **must complete the marriage preparation procedure** at the **chancery** of the Regional Consular Center in Bangkok. An appointment is mandatory and can be booked online here.

Information sheets and lists of required documentation are available in German, French and Thai here.

Second step:

After finishing civil status matters with the chancery, **visa applications** may directly be submitted at the counter of the visa section, **on the same day, without prior appointment**. Requirements below.

Documentary requirements for a national visa type D application

- > 3 national (type D) visa application forms duly completed, dated and signed by the applicant
- 4 identical passport photos made within the last 3 months in color with neutral light background. The head must take up 70-80% of the surface
- > Passport of the applicant
 - must be valid at least 3 months after the planned arrival date in Switzerland
 - must contain at least 2 blank pages
- **2 photocopies** of the personal data page of the passport of the applicant
- 2 photocopies of the Swiss Passport or the resident permit of the partner residing in Switzerland
- It would be advisable, but not mandatory, to submit a **Thai police clearance report in English**. Police Clearance Service Center, Special Branch Bureau, Section 3, Royal Thai Police Rama I, Rd. Pathumwan, Bangkok 10330. Tel. +66 2 205 2168-9, pcsc@police.go.th.

N.B.: Additional documents may be asked directly from the competent Migration Office. In this case, the document must be submitted directly to the Migration Office and not to the Embassy

Fees

Visa application-handling fees levied by the Regional Consular Center are published here

Procedure

- Civil status documents are forwarded once a week by the chancery to the civil registry office competent for the celebration of the marriage in Switzerland this may take up to 4 weeks to reach the competent office in Switzerland.
- ➤ The visa applications are sent by the Visa section once a week to the migration office competent for the place of residence of the partner in Switzerland. This may take up to 4 weeks to reach the competent office in Switzerland.
- > The overall process may take 8 to 12 weeks and information regarding the processing time is exclusively given by the authorities in Switzerland.
- The partner in Switzerland is generally informed by the Swiss civil registry office as soon as the marriage can take place.
- > Once the authorization to enter Switzerland has been granted, the partner in Switzerland receives a confirmation entitled "Ermächtigung zur Visumerteilung" or "Autorisation habilitant les representations suisses à délivrer un visa".
- ➤ The passport and the authorization can be sent directly by post (with a self-addressed envelope) to the Swiss Visa section in Bangkok or brought by the applicant or a third person during opening hours with prior appointment. (Choose Visa → Visa D → Collection)
- > The visa is generally issued on the same day.
