# Switzerland at the 2024 Paris Olympics

## July 26 - August 11, 2024

If you're wondering where to get your Swiss Olympic news and fun facts, then look no further! Did you know that Swiss watch brand OMEGA has served as the official timekeeper for the Olympic and Paralympic Games since 1932? Since extreme precision in timing is essential to Olympic competition, it only makes sense that Swiss excellence would step up to the challenge. But OMEGA is not the only Swiss representative at the Games. With just three days of competition remaining, Switzerland has won seven medals of all colors. Since 21-year-old Audrey Gogniat earned the country its first medal at these Games (a bronze in 10m rifle shooting), Swiss athletes have won medals in triathlon, swimming, rowing, BMX racing, and more. In addition, Switzerland has earned 30 Olympic Diplomas, awarded to athletes who finish in the top 8 of their events. The town's most anticipated annual events include: Fasnacht, the Follow Your Bliss Music Festival, Switzerland's National Day, monthly square dances, and the upcoming Helvetia Community Fair on September 10. If you're a Swiss food lover, you can enjoy delicious Swiss food with an Appalachian twist at the local restaurant, The Hütte. Or you can book a tour with Dave, a local guide, to learn about the cantonal flags displayed outside every building. There is a lot to do in this small town, which is about a 4.5-hour drive from DC.
