

Deadline: December 31, 2024

The Consulate General of Switzerland in San Francisco and the Heidiseum (home of the UNESCO Heidi Archive) have extended the deadline for artists, professionals, and aficionados from all backgrounds from the United States and Switzerland to showcase their unique interpretations of the Swiss icon Heidi. The beloved character from Johanna Spyri's classic novel has enchanted audiences worldwide since 1880, but in the age of Al and generative technologies, how would you reimagine Heidi? Does Heidi's love for nature change in a world of Al? We'd love to see your creative answers to these questions! We are looking for artwork that not only explores the creative potential of Al to reimagine Heidi, but also involves and expresses ethical, cultural, and artistic implications of Al in reshaping traditional narratives of Heidi. Winners will be selected by our international jury, and in addition to cash prizes selected art will be part of a two-month long exhibition in San Francisco in spring 2025 and discussed during panels on topics such as the impact of Al on art and copyright.
