I

ACCESSION OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Based on Article XXI of the Convention, the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 19 January 1984, an instrument of accession to the Convention.

According to Article XXII, Paragraph 2, of the Convention, the accession of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago will take effect on 18 April 1984.

II

ACCESSION OF BENIN

Based on Article XXI of the Convention, the People's Republic of Benin has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 28 February 1984, an instrument of accession to the Convention.

According to Article XXII, Paragraph 2, of the Convention, the accession of the People's Republic of Benin will take effect on 28 May 1984.

III

AMENDMENT OF 22 JUNE 1979 TO THE CONVENTION

The Republic of Panama has accepted on 28 October 1983, by depositing an instrument with the Swiss Government, the Amendment to Article XI, Paragraph 3, sub-paragraph a), adopted at Bonn on 22 June 1979.

This Amendment is not yet in force.

The present notification is made in conformity with Article XXV, Paragraph 2, of the Convention.
