Hong Kong Birth Certificates do not state the family name (surname) of the newborn. First (given) names are written in capital letters only. So there are not any accent-bearing letters, which may be common in French names. It is therefore vital that you complete this form and indicate the correct spelling of your baby's complete name (e.g. with accents if applicable). You may then submit this application together with the birth certificate of your newborn to this Consulate General.

- **Birth Certificate of foreign parent** issued within last 6 months;
- **Evidence of marital status of foreign parent** (e.g. Certificate of Absence of Marriage Record if NEVER married, divorce decree if divorced or death certificate of previous spouse if widowed).
