



## **Standardized multilingual medical certificates**

Dear Swiss citizens,

I would like to inform you on the latest developments regarding the implementation of the regulation on re-entry permits to Korea for long-term visa holders, which entered into force on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.

The Embassy has informed in previous emails on the basic rule that a re-entry permit has to be obtained before leaving Korea and that a medical certificate issued not earlier than 48 hours prior to the return has to be presented upon arrival to the immigration authority at the airport.

In order to make it easier to obtain this medical certificate in Switzerland, I am pleased to send you two standardized multilingual forms prepared by the consular section of the Embassy and recognized by the Korean Immigration Service. They are also available on our website

The Embassy would like to remind you that it is still mandatory for people residing in Korea and arriving from abroad to undergo a strict 14-day quarantine at home and to be tested within 3 days.
