



Travel advices in South Korea

In order to reduce the spread of the new coronavirus (COVID-19) in South Korea, the Korean government has introduced new measures nationwide. Public events have largely been cancelled. Some museums have been temporarily closed. Schools and universities have also been temporarily closed. New measures cannot be ruled out and the situation may change rapidly.

It is not recommended to travel to Daegu city and Gyeongsangbuk-do province. In general, unnecessary trips in Korea should be avoided.
